- (1) A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, RATIFYING THE CITY MANAGER'S APPOINTMENT OF INDIVIDUALS TO SERVE AS SPECIAL MASTERS FOR THE CITY'S CODE ENFORCEMENT PROCESS; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (SPONSORED BY THE CITY MANAGER)** This item was amended to include Attorney Olivia Benson, as Special Master and approved by a 6-0 vote. Councilwoman King was not present for this vote.
