A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, DETERMINING CERTAIN EXERCISE EQUIPMENT DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" TO BE SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO DISPOSE OF THE SURPLUS ITEMS; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The City Council approved the purchase of the Police and Public Works Building on April 11, 2007, and

WHEREAS, certain exercise/weight equipment was included in the purchase and was donated to the City for its use, and

WHEREAS, the space designated for the Police Department gymnasium has since been allocated for additional use by the Police Motor Unit and School Crossing Guard staff; and therefore, there will not be adequate room to use the equipment or to store it, and

WHEREAS, City Purchasing Department staff has determined that the equipment is in "fair" condition and has some value, and

WHEREAS, the City participated in the Southeast Florida Cooperative Group RFP for Auction Services, and Fisher Auction Company, Inc. located in Miami, Florida was awarded "On-Site Auction Services" and Lone Star Auctioneers, Inc. located in Ft. Worth, Texas was awarded "Internet Auction Services," and

WHEREAS, upon approval, City staff will arrange to have one of the Auction companies auction the miscellaneous equipment and office supplies,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. DETERMINATION OF SURPLUS: The City Council of the City of Miami Gardens hereby determines the exercise/weight equipment listed on Exhibit "A" attached hereto to be surplus. Further, the City Council authorizes the City Manager to dispose of the surplus items in a manner he deems appropriate.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its final passage.

## Staff Summary

The City Council approved the purchase of the Police and Public Works properties on April 11, 2007. The exercise/weight equipment was included in the purchase and donated to the Police Department for their use. The space which was designated for the gym has since been allocated for additional use by the MGPD motor unit and School Crossing Guard staff. As such there will not be adequate room to use the equipment nor is there room to store it.

In performing an inventory of the equipment, the condition is considered "fair" and would require repairs before being used. Using them in the current condition would present some concerns of potential liability. We recommended declaring these items as surplus. An inventory of this equipment is attached (**Exhibit A**).

The City participated in the Southeast Florida Cooperative Group RFP for Auction Services. Fisher Auction Company, Inc. located in Miami, Florida was awarded "On-Site Auction Services" and Lone Star Auctioneers, Inc. located in Ft. Worth, Texas was awarded "Internet Auction Services". Staff will arrange to have one of the Auction companies auction the miscellaneous equipment and office supplies.
