

RESOLUTION No. 2005-147-324

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ISSUE A PURCHASE ORDER TO BEA INTERNATIONAL IN THE AMOUNT OF FOUR HUNDRED TWENTY-THREE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED ELEVEN (\$423,111.00) DOLLARS FOR ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES RELATING TO THE PARKS AND RECREATION MASTER PLAN, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROPOSAL ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT "A", PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in the next five (5) years, the City of Miami Gardens will receive over Thirty-Two Million (\$32,000,000.00) Dollars to renovate sixteen (16) city parks, and

WHEREAS, the City will receive funds from Miami-Dade County, the State of Florida and City Capital Improvement Funds, and

WHEREAS, City staff has developed a process for the creation of a Parks and Recreation Master Plan, and

WHEREAS, the City has previously contracted with professional architectural and engineering firms via Non-Exclusive Continuing Contracts, and

WHEREAS, one of the firms that the City contracted with was BEA International ("BEA"), and

WHEREAS, the City proposes that BEA will complete four (4) major tasks at Andover Park, Cloverleaf Park, Brentwood Park, Buccaneer Park, Carol City Community Center, Lake Lucerne, North Dade Optimist, Norwood Park & Pool and Vista Verde Park in obtaining the necessary surveying and geotechnical work, planning the park layouts through community involvement, completing a conceptual design for each park, and providing full construction documents for bidding, and

WHEREAS, BEA has provided the City with an estimate for providing the services

required at each of the parks and a proposal for completing the tasks at the Parks, and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that the costs will not exceed Four Hundred Twenty-Three Thousand One Hundred Eleven (\$423,111.00) Dollars, and

WHEREAS, the City Manager is recommending that the City Council permit BEA to provide the requested services pursuant to the continuing contract that was executed between the City and BEA on April 27, 2005.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS.

Section 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

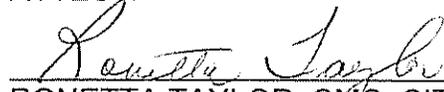
Section 2. AUTHORIZATION. The City Manager of the City of Miami Gardens is hereby authorized to issue a purchase order to BEA International to complete four (4) major tasks listed below in an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Twenty-Three Thousand One Hundred Eleven (\$423,111.00) Dollars in accordance with the Proposal submitted by BEA International, attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its final passage.
