

RESOLUTION No. 2004-105-156

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE SOFTWARE AND HARDWARE FROM DELL SYSTEMS, THROUGH SALVANT & ASSOCIATES INC., OR DIRECTLY FROM DELL SYSTEMS, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SIXTY TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$62,000); AUTHORIZING A WAIVER OF THE COMPETITIVE BID REQUIREMENTS PURSUANT TO ARTICLE V OF ORDINANCE 2004-17, THE CITY'S PURCHASING ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, City Hall is currently undergoing an expansion, and as a result, additional network service, hardware, and software programs must installed, and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended that the City contract with Salvant & Associates, Inc., for the installation and configuration of the network service, hardware and software programs required for the expansion, and

WHEREAS, the City Manager recommends that the City purchase the required hardware and software from Dell Systems, and

WHEREAS, if the necessary hardware and software is purchased from Dell Systems, through Salvant & Associates, the City will realize a 12% government discount, and

WHEREAS, the City Manager recommends that the City waive the competitive bidding requirements of Article V of the City's Purchasing Ordinance due to the time constraints and in light of the fact that the current City Hall system is a Dell system and utilizing Dell in the expansion area will provide for standardization and compatibility, and

WHEREAS, City staff solicited informal quotes from three companies prior to make

the recommendation that the City Council purchase the necessary items from Dell & Associates, and

WHEREAS, the City Council would like to accept the recommendation of the City Manager,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. AUTHORIZATION: The City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase hardware and software in an amount not to exceed Sixty Two Thousand Dollars (\$62,000.00), from Dell Systems, through Salvant & Associates, Inc., or directly from Dell Systems.

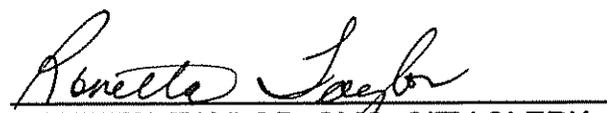
