

**RESOLUTION NO. 2004-41-92**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO FINALIZE AN AGREEMENT WITH WORLD WASTE SERVICES, INC., FOR THE PROVISION OF SOLID WASTE REMOVAL SERVICES IN ALL CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS PARKS; PROVIDING FOR A WAIVER OF THE COMPETITIVE BID REQUIREMENTS OF ORDINANCE NO. 2004-17; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE AND ATTEST, RESPECTIVELY SAID AGREEMENT; PROVIDING FOR DIRECTIONS TO THE CITY CLERK; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Miami-Dade County Parks and Recreation Department currently has contracts with four separate vendors for the provision of solid waste removal services for parks located within the City of Miami Gardens, and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County has requested that the City either assume the existing County's existing contracts, or make adequate arrangements to provide solid waste removal services through another vendor, and

WHEREAS, in an effort to streamline the number of contractors providing solid waste removal services for the City's parks, staff believes it is in the best interest of the City to utilize one vendor for the remainder of this fiscal year, and to subsequently issue a RFP for solid waste removal services in the City's parks for the following fiscal years, and

WHEREAS, City staff sought informal proposals from four vendors, and

WHEREAS, of the four vendors contacted, three vendors provided quotes, and

WHEREAS, World Waste Services, Inc., provided the lowest quote of all of the vendors contacted, a copy of said quote being attached hereto as Exhibit "A," and

WHEREAS, World Waste Services, Inc., is qualified to provide the services, and

WHEREAS, time is of the essence since Miami-Dade County no longer wants the responsibility of providing the solid waste removal services to the City, and

WHEREAS, the City Manager is recommending that the competitive bid requirements of Ordinance No. 2004-17 be waived in light of the fact that time is of the essence,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1:** ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

**Section 2:** AUTHORIZATION: The City Manager is hereby authorized to finalize an agreement with World Waste Services, Inc., for the provision of solid waste removal services in all City of Miami Gardens Parks, in accordance with the quote attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

**Section 3:** WAIVER OF COMPETITIVE BID REQUIREMENTS: The competitive bid requirements of Ordinance No. 2004-17 are hereby waived.


**Section 4:** AUTHORIZATION: Upon finalization of the agreement with World Waste Services, Inc., the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute and attest respectively said agreement.

**Section 5:** INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CITY CLERK: The City Clerk is hereby authorized to obtain three (3) fully executed copies of the fully executed agreement, with one to be maintained by the City; with one to be delivered to World Waste Services, Inc., and with one to be directed to the Office of City Attorney.

**Section 6:** MAYOR AUTHORIZED: The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign this resolution.

**Section 7.** EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
