

RESOLUTION NO 2005-04-181

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE EIGHT (8) MODULAR WORK STATIONS/OFFICES, FROM PRIDE ENTERPRISES, FOR A PRICE NOT TO EXCEED TWENTY-NINE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED FIFTY AND 15/100 (\$29,150.15) DOLLARS; AUTHORIZING A WAIVER OF THE COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, City Hall has been expanded to include office space to the south of the current City Hall, and

WHEREAS, the City Manager proposes to place a total of twelve (12) work stations/offices and a conference room in the City Hall addition, and

WHEREAS, the City Manager would like to immediately purchase and install eight (8) modular work stations/offices, and

WHEREAS, City staff contacted two (2) companies which currently have State of Florida contracts for modular offices, and

WHEREAS, PRIDE Enterprises provided the best proposal to the City because their proposal included not only work stations/offices but task lighting, shelving units, pedestal desks and file drawers and was the overall lowest bidder, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City's Purchasing Order, any and all purchases that exceed Twenty-Five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars are to be competitively bid, and

WHEREAS, City staff made the determination that it was not efficient to competitively bid the purchase of the modular work stations, and is requesting that the City Council waive the competitive bidding requirement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. AUTHORIZATION: The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to expend a sum not to exceed Twenty-Nine Thousand One Hundred Fifty and 15/100 (\$29,150.15) Dollars for the purchase of eight (8) modular work stations/offices from PRIDE Enterprises for City Hall.

Section 3. WAIVER OF COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS: The City Council hereby waives the competitive bidding requirements of the City's Purchasing Ordinance and authorizes the City Manager to purchase the work stations/offices from PRIDE Enterprises.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its final passage.
