A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, CANCELLING THE NOVEMBER 23, 2005, CITY COUNCIL MEETING; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. CANCELLATION OF MEETING: The City Council of Miami Gardens hereby cancels the regular City Council meeting scheduled for November 23, 2005 at 7:00 p m.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its final passage.
