

RESOLUTION No. 2005-39-216

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF CITY EMPLOYEES; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, as the City moves forward, it will become necessary for the Manager to increase City staff positions to accommodate the ever-increasing needs of the City, and

WHEREAS, the City Manager recognizes that there is a need for an increase in full-time staff positions at the City to accommodate the City's growth, and

WHEREAS, the City Manager is recommending that fourteen (14) additional full-time staff members be added to the City's staff, and

WHEREAS, there are a number of grants that the City has received that will assist the City in offsetting the salaries of some of the additional staff members, and

WHEREAS, the 2004-2005 budget anticipated the hiring of these employees,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. AUTHORIZATION: The City Council for the City of Miami Gardens hereby authorizes the City Manager to add the following new, full-time staff positions:
