

RESOLUTION No. 2006-04-350

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, EXPRESSING THE INTENT OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO RENAME "CAROL PARK" TO AUDREY J. KING PARK; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Honorable Audrey J King faithfully served as a member of the City Council for the City of Miami Gardens from the inception of the City until her untimely passing on September 30, 2005, and

WHEREAS, even before her tenure as a Councilmember for the City of Miami Gardens, Audrey J. King worked tirelessly in the City of Miami Gardens for the benefit of its residents, and

WHEREAS, Ms. King was the first person to serve in City Council Seat 3, and

WHEREAS, upon completion of ongoing construction, pursuant to the City's Interlocal Agreement with Miami-Dade County, Carol Park will be deeded to the City of Miami Gardens, and

WHEREAS, to honor the memory of Councilwoman Audrey J. King, the City Council for the City of Miami Gardens would like to rename Carol Park as the "Audrey J. King Park" to serve as a permanent reminder of Ms. King's tireless efforts on behalf of the City of Miami Gardens,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. PARK RENAMING: After conveyance of Carol Park to the City of

Miami Gardens from Miami-Dade County, the City Council for the City of Miami Gardens hereby express its official intent to change the name of "Carol Park", to "Audrey J King Park".

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its final passage.
