A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM (CERT) SUB-GRANT FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,309.00, A COPY OF WHICH IS ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT "A"; PROVIDING FOR INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CITY CLERK; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Miami Gardens has been approved for Federal Fiscal Year 2006 Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) sub-grant funding from the Florida Department of Community Affairs in the amount of \$15,309.00, and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the CERT Program is to promote a partnership between local emergency services and the people they serve, and

WHEREAS, this is accomplished by training citizens, neighborhoods, community organizations and workplaces in basic emergency preparedness, response and recovery skills to function in a neighbor-helping-neighbor-helping their community spirit and to train citizens to function as auxiliary personnel to first responders, and

WHEREAS, the sub-grant funds are for CERT kits, supplies, reference materials, and to provide training,

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to enter into an agreement with the State Department of Community Affairs and proceed with the commencement of the CERT Program,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. AUTHORIZATION: The City Manager for the City of Miami Gardens is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement with the Florida Department of Community Affairs for Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) sub-grant funding, attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

Section 3. INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CITY CLERK: The City Clerk is hereby authorized to obtain three (3) fully executed copies of the subject Agreement, with one to be maintained by the City; with one to be delivered to the Florida Department of Community Affairs; and with one to be directed to the Office of City Attorney.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its final passage.
