

RESOLUTION No. 2006-157-503

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE AND ATTEST, RESPECTIVELY, THAT CERTAIN AGREEMENT WITH MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, THROUGH ITS DEPARTMENT AND SYSTEM SERVICES FOR FEDERAL DRUG CONTROL AND SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT FORMULA GRANT PROGRAM FUNDING, A COPY OF WHICH IS ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT "A"; AUTHORIZING A MATCH; PROVIDING FOR INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CITY CLERK; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County, through its Department of Human Services implements the Federal Drug Control And System Improvement Formula Grant Program ("Grant Program"), and

WHEREAS, the City of Miami Gardens has been awarded the total sum of \$11,372.00 through the full grant for the implementation of a drug prevention and awareness program at six (6) elementary schools within the city limits, and

WHEREAS, in order to participate in the Grant funding, the City is required to provide a twenty-five (25%) match of grant funds (\$3,791.00), and

WHEREAS, the City will use the funds to provide a School Resource Officer Program for drug prevention and awareness, and

WHEREAS, City Council would like to authorize the City Manager to execute an Agreement with Miami-Dade County, through its Department of Human Services, to receive Grant Program funding.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. AUTHORITY: The City Manager and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute and attest, respectively, that certain Agreement with Miami-Dade County, through its Department of Human Services for the use of Federal Drug Control and System Improvement Formula Grant Program Funding, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

Section 3. AUTHORIZING A MATCH: The City Council of the City of Miami Gardens hereby authorizes a twenty-five (25%) percent match of funds in the amount of Three Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety-One Dollars (\$3,791) Dollars.

Section 4. INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CITY CLERK: The City Clerk is hereby authorized to obtain three (3) fully executed copies of the subject Agreement, with one to be maintained by the City; with one to be delivered to Miami-Dade County, and with one to be directed to the Office of the City Attorney.

Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its final passage.

## MEMORANDUM

Re: Drug Control and System Improvement Program

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### **Background:**

The attached legislation authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with Miami Dade County Department of Human Services for the implementation of a School Resource Officer Program at the six elementary schools within the City limits. The program will focus on drug prevention and awareness. The total program budget for this year grants \$11,372 to the Miami Gardens, with a 25% match in the amount of \$3,791.

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the City Council approve the agreement thereby authorizing the City Manager to execute such document, in order to continue the drug awareness and prevention program within the elementary schools as part of the Federal Drug Control and System Improvement Formula Grant Program. Further, it is also recommended the Council approve the required 25% matching requirement.
