

RESOLUTION No. 2008-57-744

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, DECLARING THAT THE TRASH COMPACTOR DESCRIBED ON THE EXHIBIT ATTACHED HERETO IS SURPLUS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AUCTION THE SAME TO THE HIGHEST BIDDER; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on April 11, 2007, the City Council authorized the purchase of property to house the Public Works Department, and

WHEREAS, included with that original purchase was a trash contractor, and

WHEREAS, City staff has made a determination that the City does not have a need for the trash compactor, and

WHEREAS, City staff estimates that the value of the trash compactor exceeds \$5,000.00, and

WHEREAS, City staff is recommending that the City Council authorize the City Manager to auction off the trash compactor,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. DETERMINATION OF SURPLUS: The City Council of the City of Miami Gardens hereby determines the trash compactor depicted on the Exhibits attached hereto, to be surplus. The City Council further authorizes the City Manager to auction off the trash compactor to the highest bidder.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its final passage.

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Staff Summary

On April 11, 2007, City Council authorized the purchase of property to house the Public Works Department. Included with this purchase was a trash compactor. Staff has determined that we do not have a need for this equipment.

Analysis:

The City participated in the Southeast Florida Cooperative Group RFP for Auction Services. Fisher Auction Company, Inc. located in Miami, Florida was awarded "On-Site Auction Services" and Lone Star Auctioneers, Inc. located in Ft. Worth, Texas was awarded "Internet Auction Services". Staff will arrange to have Lone Star Auctioneers auction the trash compactor. A picture of the equipment is attached.

That the City Council approve the attached resolution authorizing the City Manager to dispose of the surplus property.




