

Parking Permits for Work Vehicles, RV's and Boats

Are you wondering why you received a postcard about residential parking? Our new Zoning Code allows City residents to legally park small work vehicles in their driveways. That wasn't allowed under the county code.

Note: **These requirements do not apply to personal vehicles that are not used for business purposes**; you do not need a permit to park the vehicle you drive to and from work.

City-wide Mailer: Every property owner and business received the parking permit postcard ([click here](#)). The new parking program includes:

1. Residential Vehicle Parking Permit for Commercial Vehicles or Boats and RV's:
 - a. The application in residentially zoned areas is \$28.75 annually (or \$2.40 per month). For an application, [click here](#).
 - b. The permit card is designed to hang from the mirror of the vehicle ([click here](#)).
2. Industrial Property Parking Permit: The application for industrial property owners to allow parking for vehicles associated with businesses that are not on site is \$287.50 annually (or \$23.90 per month). For an application, [click here](#).
3. Zoning Hotline: The Planning and Zoning Department's new phone message provides an FAQ-type format that summarizes vehicle parking plus other common questions such as shed setbacks and fence requirements. The hotline number is 305-622-8023, then choose 1.
4. Information Flyers, Handouts and Applications: [Click here](#).
5. Code Compliance: The Code Compliance Division issues warnings that inform residents that they now can and must obtain a permit to park their small commercial and recreation vehicles at their homes.
