

INSTALLATION OF TRANSIT AMMENITIES ABUTTING SINGLE FAMILY HOMES

From time to time bus riders request installation of transit amenities to enhance existing bus stops i.e. bus benches, trash receptacles, etc. The department recognizes that transit amenities provide comfort and convenience to bus riders. Furthermore, the department recognizes that transit amenities may conflict with the interests and the needs of homeowners where bus stops abuts their property. This policy is established to set guidelines for the installation of transit amenities.

Transit amenities requests submitted to the department will be investigated by the Public Works Director or his/her designee to determine that right-of-way is available to accommodate the proposed improvement. Once right-of-way availability has been established, the department representative will request written consent from the impacted property owner. If the property owner opposes the installation of the transit amenity, the request will be denied and the requestor will be notified of the decision. Once consent from the property owner has been received, the department will proceed to install the requested transit amenities.
